Canine Neuter:

We recommend neutering pets for three major reasons:

1. No unwanted pregnancies
2. Reduces your pet’s risk for prostate or testicular cancers
3. Helps to reduce aggression or marking behaviors

We have found it to work best to just do a price range over an exact cost for this type of procedure:

\$525-\$800

Factors that would cause the price to increase would be is the size of your pet, if a scrotal tack is necessary, if you request a microchip (\$76.00), if your pet has an umbilical hernia, suffers from cryptorchidism or baby teeth. If bloodwork has been done within the last 3 months, this could decrease the price. If for some reason we expect it to be more than this range we will reach out to you.
